The Nebraska Administrative Office of the Courts and Probation are pleased to announce Training for all Adult Drug and DUI Court Teams in Nebraska, or any Judge interested in starting an Adult Drug or DUI or Veterans Problem-Solving Court in Nebraska.

A team from the National Center for State Courts (NCSC) will facilitate an interactive training session designed to provide information about Nebraska's Adult Drug and DUI Court Best Practice Standards. This free 2-day training opportunity will also include a half day training provided by the Montana Veterans Treatment Court Team headed by Judge Mary J. Knisely. Judge Knisely and her Team will provide a training regarding an Overview of Veterans Treatment Courts and how Drug Courts can address responsivity issues with Vets in their Adult Drug and DUI Courts.

- Interested Judges who are considering a problem-solving court are also welcome
- Technical assistance available

In addition, each existing Team will be also provided technical assistance from the NCSC to update their policies and procedures to more effectively align with the Standards. NCSC will also provide information and answer questions about the meaning and interpretation of critical Standards. Drug or DUI Court Teams will be expected to sit together and bring the following: their most recent Self-Assessment Tool and Policy and Procedures Manual.
